



# Privacy Statement on the protection of personal data in relation to organisation of events and other meetings and use of personal data at EU-OSHA<sup>1</sup>

## Organizational part of the Agency entrusted with the processing of personal data

Director

## Purpose of processing of personal data

- To process participation in events and other meetings organised by the Agency;
- To draw up a list of participants which is distributed at the event and might be published;
- To manage the event documentation and the Agency's (printed and online) publications as well as social media posts following an event;
- To manage partnerships and working relations with participants including to carry out surveys to obtain feedback on the Agency's work.

## Type of data processed

- Identification data: last name, first name, organization, department, business email, professional
  title, job title, business telephone, business mobile phone, business fax and contact details of
  assistant(s) if applicable, photographs, video streamings or short videos, which are being made
  during an event;

# Legal basis

• Council Regulation (EC) No. 2062/34 of 18/07/1994 establishing the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work and subsequent amendments.

## Lawfulness of processing

The processing is based on Article 5(a) and (d) of <u>Regulation (EU) 2018/1725</u> of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter the Regulation)

## Recipients of the data processed

- Agency' staff;
- Agency's private contractors with prior authorization from the Agency and only for the purposes
  of the performance, management and follow-up of the contract (e.g., organization of meetings
  and conferences);

#### The data subject's rights

Data subjects have the right to request from the controller access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning the data subject or, where applicable, the right to object to processing or the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal (Articles 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23 and 24 of the Regulation).

Data subjects' rights can be restricted only in the cases foreseen in Art 25 of the Regulation.

## Information on the conservation period of personal data

All personal data are stored as long as it is necessary for managing the working relations with participants.

#### Security measures

We take appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorised access to or unauthorised alteration, disclosure or destruction of data. These include internal reviews of our data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures, including appropriate encryption of communication and physical security measures to guard against unauthorised access to systems where we store personal data.
